

I could easily report that retirees will continue to receive their monthly retirement checks and that their health care coverage will remain.

But, here is a quick overview of this year's legislative session in Annapolis:

Over 2500 bills were submitted by our legislators.

Bills were introduced that would affect or change the retirement system for those persons working. Most of these bills did not make it out of committee.

Closer to home, our health care system is negotiated for us by TABCO through its Master Agreement. BCRSPA is fortunate to have a close working relationship with BCPS and receive updates to our program at our general meetings in the Spring and Fall.
